Who Should Attend Parent Involvement Trainings?

- ❖ The Parent Involvement training is recommended for participants from all Title 1 schools, and is **especially designed for Program Improvement districts and schools.**
- ❖ Teams from districts and county offices of education (and individuals) are encouraged to attend. School teams may include: an administrator, teachers, parent leaders, and parent liaisons/paraprofessionals. School Site Council members and PTA/parent organization members should also attend.
- ❖ Trainings meet NCLB requirement for districts and schools to provide parent involvement training for staff and parents.

Parent Involvement Training Content:

- ◆ Using successful partnership strategies at elementary, middle and high school levels to increase student achievement.
- ◆ Using research-based recruitment strategies to increase parent and community participation in partnership activities.
- ◆ Setting up an effective action team to plan partnership activities that meet NCLB parent involvement requirements.
- ◆ Identifying the strengths of your culturally and linguistically diverse school community and building a welcoming school climate.
- ◆ Identifying strategies to build parent leadership skills.
- ◆ Providing opportunities to meet parent and school leaders from other county offices, districts and schools to learn what programs and practices are working for them.
